- How long has your company been installing piers?
- What is your company's BBB rating and do you have a Complaint Free Award?
- What is your company's Angle's List Rating?
- Is your company an EBESCO Research Best Pick?
- Does your company recycle all concrete and hydraulic oil?
- Are your piers manufactured in North America using high-quality domestic steel?
- Is your pier certified with the following codes:
 - 2000 International Building Code?
 - BOCA National Building Code?
 - 1999 Standard Building Code?
 - 1997 Uniform Building Code?
 - 2000 International Residential Building Code?
 - 1998 International One and Two Family Dwelling Code?
- Does your piering system meet the stringent quality control standards of ISO 9001?
